Parents evenings

Dates for parents evening are as follows:

Tuesday 29th September – 5pm – 7.30pm Wednesday 30th September – 3.30pm – 6pm

For you, as parents, nothing has changed. You will log on to the parent booking system the same way as usual and book your slot. During the evening, you will log back on and press a 'join video' button and you will be connected to the class teacher. After 2 minutes a warning light will come up and the system (not the teacher) will cut off after 10 minutes. If you do not have access to the internet the class teacher will be in contact to arrange further arrangements.

The booking system will open on Friday 18th September.

NHS guidelines

You do not need to isolate for a runny nose or a sore throat. If your child is unwell you would keep them off school <u>as usual</u> and this would be recorded in the same way it always was.
