## **NHS guidelines**

Please just follow the guidance we have and self-isolate / book a test for the following symptoms:

- Persistent cough
- Fever
- Loss of smell or taste

You do not need to isolate for a runny nose or a sore throat. If your child is unwell you would keep them off school <u>as usual</u> and this would be recorded in the same way it always was.

If in doubt, please phone the school.

We are only able to provide work for children who have received advice from Trace and Protect or a medical professional (not including quarantine resulting from travel). This may be physical work sent home or via technology links (Seesaw or Teams) as appropriate to their age.
